Ask your child to name who everyone is and tell you one thing he/she likes about each person.</p>	<p>20 Eat something hot today and then try to name or find pictures/items of 5 other hot things.</p>	<p>21 Put several items in a bag that makes noise. Pull out each one so your child can't see and then ask your child to tell you what each noise is.</p>
