

## Cartoon Questions

These cartoons are used to help the students create various “wh” and “How?” questions and think of an appropriate response for each question.

These cartoons can also be used as an activity to supplement story telling.

Choose the appropriate direction(s) to meet the needs of your students:

1. Print and laminate each cartoon. Use a dry erase marker and allow the student to write on the cartoons.
2. Print out each cartoon and have the students write directly on the paper.
3. Have the students use partners – Have one student create the question and the other student think of an appropriate response.
4. After completing the question and response – have the student tell a story (verbal and/or written) using their cartoon.

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
