

Haunted House

Directions: Here is an activity to help students follow **2-step auditory directions containing basic concepts**. These directions can be simplified to 1-step if needed by breaking them apart, or they can be increased to 3 or 4 steps by combining them. Remind students to listen for key words in the directions, and to follow the directions in the order given by the teacher.

Materials Needed:

Square and triangle template
Blank piece of construction paper
Scissors
Glue
Crayons/markers

2-Step Directions:

1. Cut out the square. Then cut out the triangle.
2. Glue the square to the **bottom** of your page. Then, glue the triangle on **top** of the square.
3. Draw a black door and four black windows **in** the house.
4. Draw a chimney on **top** of the roof. Then, draw smoke coming **out** of the chimney.
5. Draw a **big**, yellow moon in the **top, left** corner of your page. Then, draw a cloud **under** the moon.
6. Draw **three** bats **next to** the moon. Then, draw a black cat on **top** of the roof of the house.
7. Draw one pumpkin on the **left** side of the house. Then, draw another pumpkin on the **right** side of the house. (Can change concept to *next to* or *on each side*, if too advanced)
8. Draw a ghost **in** one window. Then draw a bat **in** another window.
9. Draw a witch sitting **on** her broom **next to** the house. Then, draw two eyes **on** the moon.
10. Get your orange crayon and write 'Happy Halloween' at the **top** of your paper.
