



Hearts Match Game



This Valentine Game is for:

- Young or low functioning students who need to practice the following skills:
 - Turn-taking
 - Matching sizes
 - Matching colors
 - Identifying colors

OR

- Any students in small group sessions as a reward for correct production or response to any speech or language task

You will need:

one printed, laminated Heart Match Game board per player
foam hearts (3 sizes, 3 colors)

source: Oriental Trading Company (200 pieces for \$1.95)

OR AC Moore (large canister, about \$8.00)

OR print extra game boards and cut out the hearts to be used for matching

To play:

Put the foam or cut-out hearts in a container that students can't see through. Students will take turns selecting a heart and placing it on the corresponding color and shape if needed. If the student already has that size/color, the heart is put back into the container. Shake the container to mix up the hearts before the next student selects a heart.

Play continues until:

- one player covers his/her board
- OR**
- all players cover their boards
- OR**
- one student has 3 in a row (like TicTacToe).
