

Directions for Mardi Gras Board Game

Cut out one set of floats. Fold in half, then fold white tabs. Paper clip tabs together. This will weight the floats so that they stay upright on the game board but can be stored flat.

Game instructions:

Game can be used to teach Mardi Gras vocabulary by discussing the items on which players land or used for any other articulation or language objectives that lend themselves to table games. Turn playing cards face down in a pile. Draw one card for each turn. The number of necklaces (or Mardi Gras Beads) on the card determines the number of spaces to move. If you have more than two players you will need to use the cards more than once. Place used cards face-up in the discard pile so they will be ready to use again.
