

# Pronoun Practice

For practice with pronouns "he" and "she." See note below for practice with "they, his, hers, theirs" and "have/has."

## To make:

Print PronounItems on card stock; cut apart and laminate. Print Pronoun1 and Pronoun2 on paper or card stock; laminate each.

## To play:

Put the Pronoun 1 and 2 pictures in front the of the students. Put six Pronoun Items cards, face up, on each Pronoun picture, so the boy and the girl each have 6 items. Ask the question, "Who has the (item)?" Students will take turns picking up the named item and answering the question, "He (or she) has the (item)."

Each time an item card is named and the question is answered, the item card is removed from play. Replace it with a new item card. Keep playing until all cards are used. There is no score (except the data you keep on correct pronoun usage), and everybody wins!

To keep the game fresh and to work on additional vocabulary, use BOARDMAKER to make different, themed item cards, such as food, toys, winter clothes, school supplies, etc.

**Note:** Use BOARDMAKER to make a third card --"they"--if you want to work on "have/has." You can also make different sentence strips for the bottom of the pronoun pictures that read "The ---(item) is his/hers/theirs" to work on possessives.

My students really enjoy this fast-paced game. I hope yours do, too!
