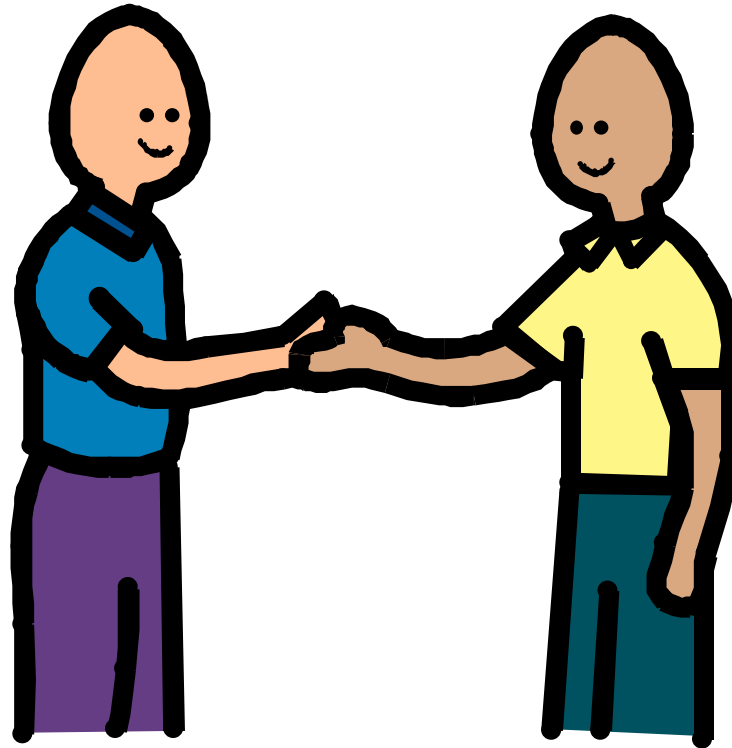


In the morning, the first time you see people, you should say, “**Good morning.**”

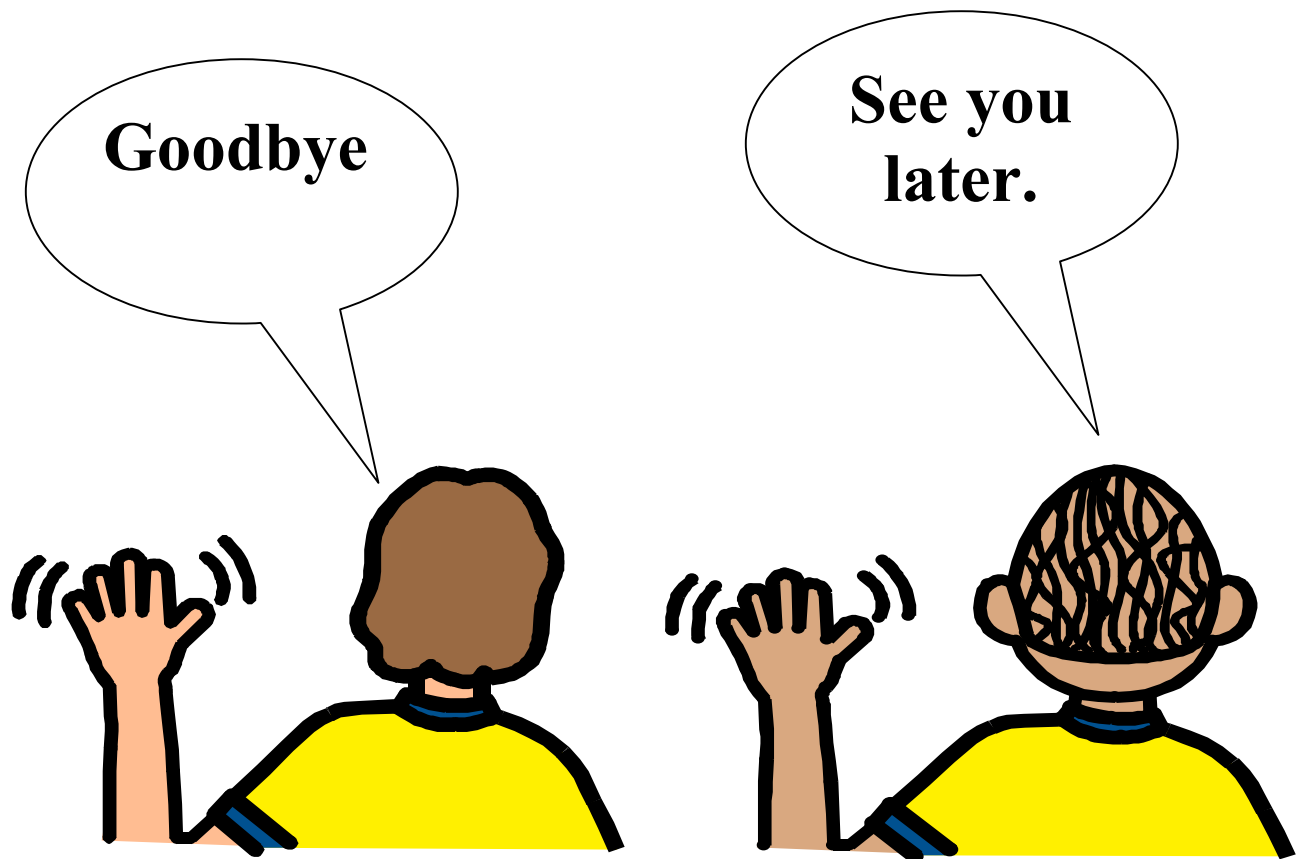
