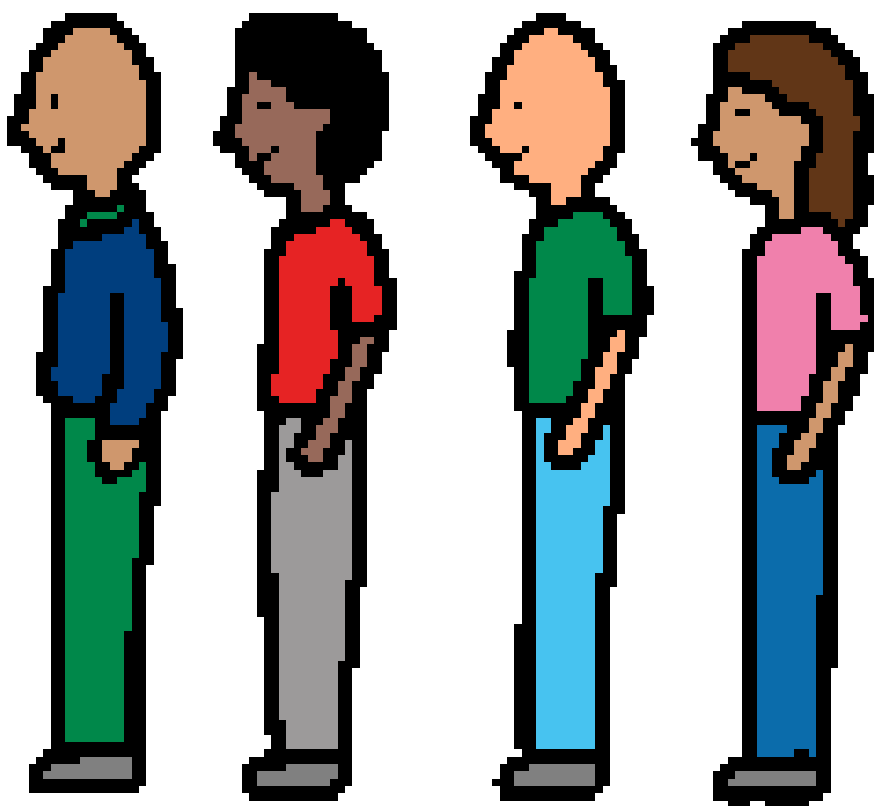


Walking in line

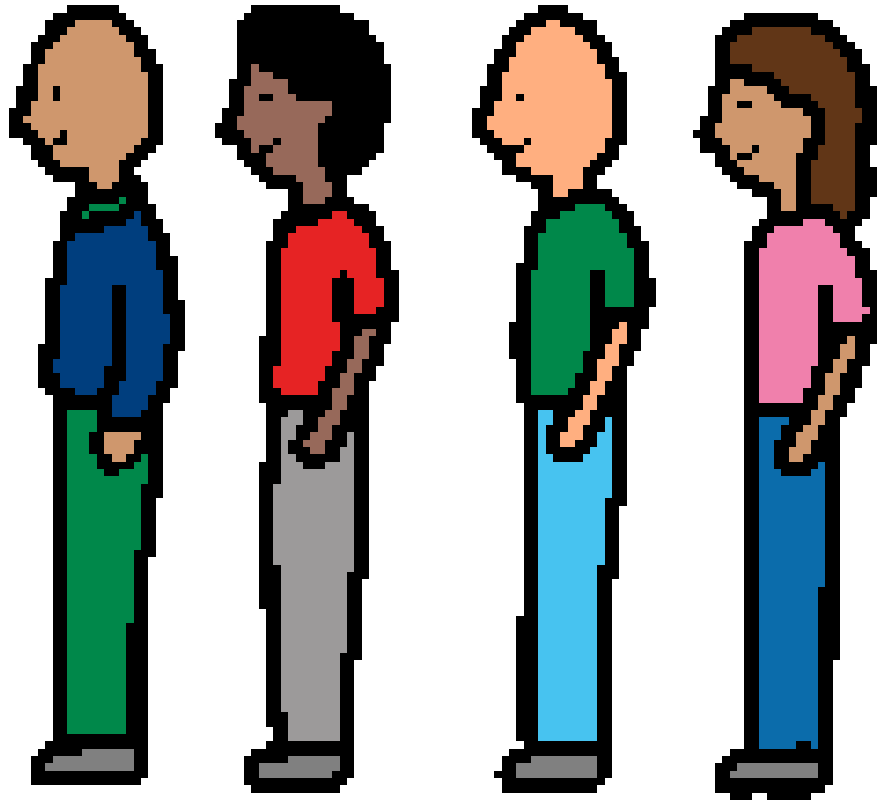

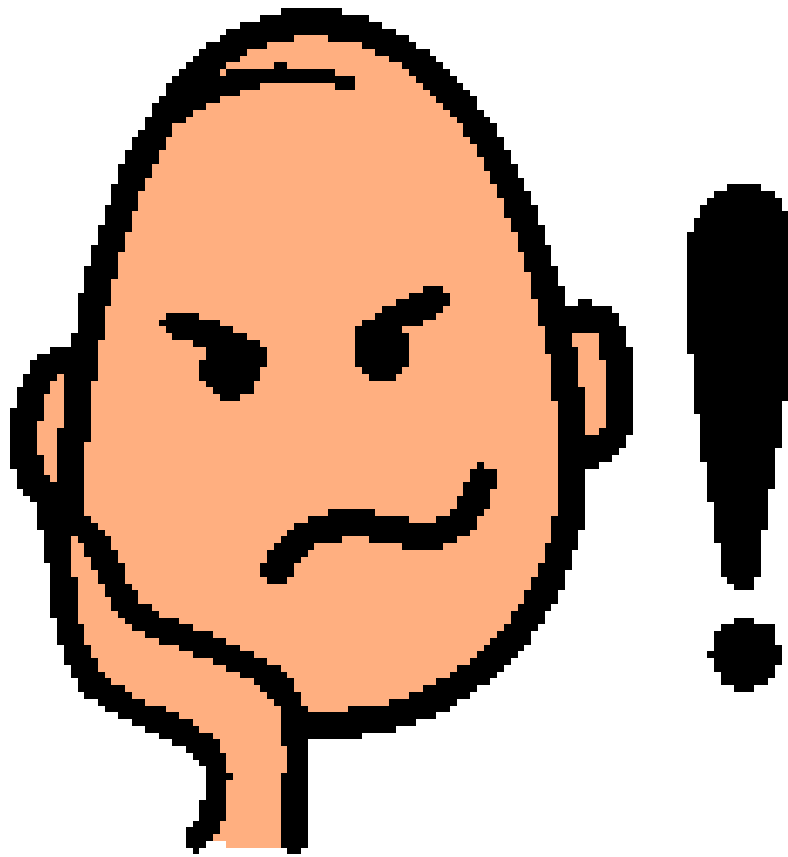

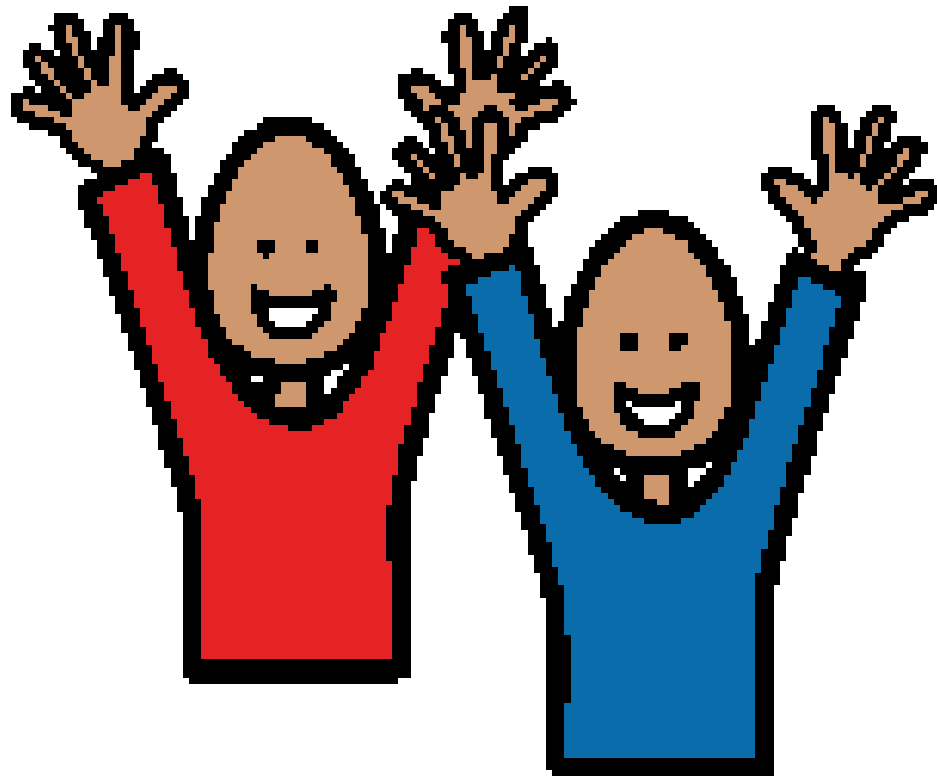
We do a lot of fun things at school. We play games, we share our toys, and we learn a lot of fun things. We even walk around our school to go from place to place.



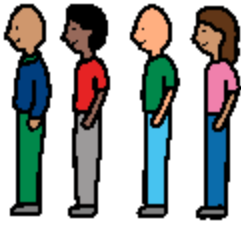
At school we walk together as a class. We walk in the hallway, we walk to the playground, and sometimes we even walk outside. At school we walk in a line when we walk together.

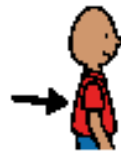


Walking in line is sometimes hard but

When we walk in a line I can:

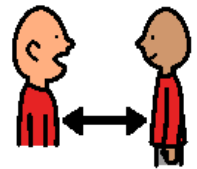
Stand behind the leader and stay behind a teacher.



Keep my hands down and against my body.



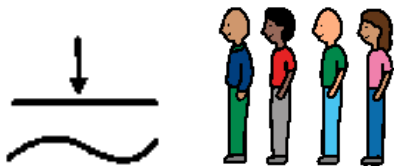
Have a quiet body and give my friends a little space.
