

Articulation Chart Directions:

It is designed to be used with “stampers.”

Some important points about the chart I’d like to share:

- ✓ It is designed to facilitate auditory identification, awareness, & discrimination skills. It allows the children to indicate *where in a word* they heard their target sound.
- ✓ The children get visual feedback as to their choices.
- ✓ When the therapist also uses a stamper, it can provide gentle feedback as to the therapist’s agreement or disagreement about the student’s choices.
- ✓ This can be used very generally for phonemic awareness activities.
- ✓ No stampers? No problem, just have the students place a check or colored smiley face in the appropriate column.

The children find it very motivating as they get to use stampers (always a hit)
