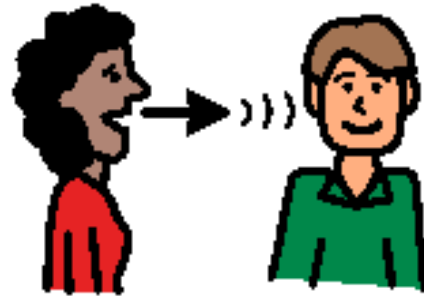
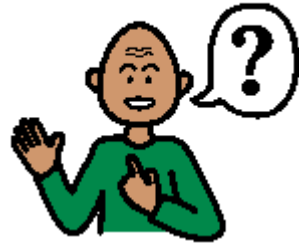


Using nice talk and
Giving directions

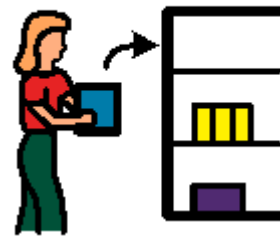


Sometimes I want to tell someone something or give a person a direction to do something.

I may want to ask someone to help me, or a friend to put a toy away, or tell someone to come to the snack table.

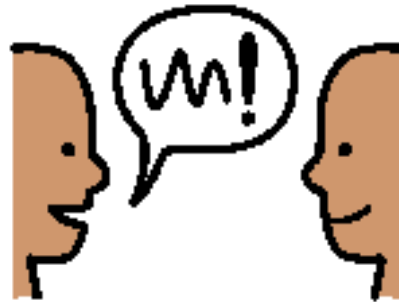
loud

Sometimes I may use a loud voice like a lion or a whining voice that squeaks like a mouse. This may make people not want to follow my direction or not listen to me.



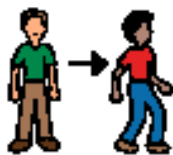
When I want to give a person a direction I can use nice talk.
