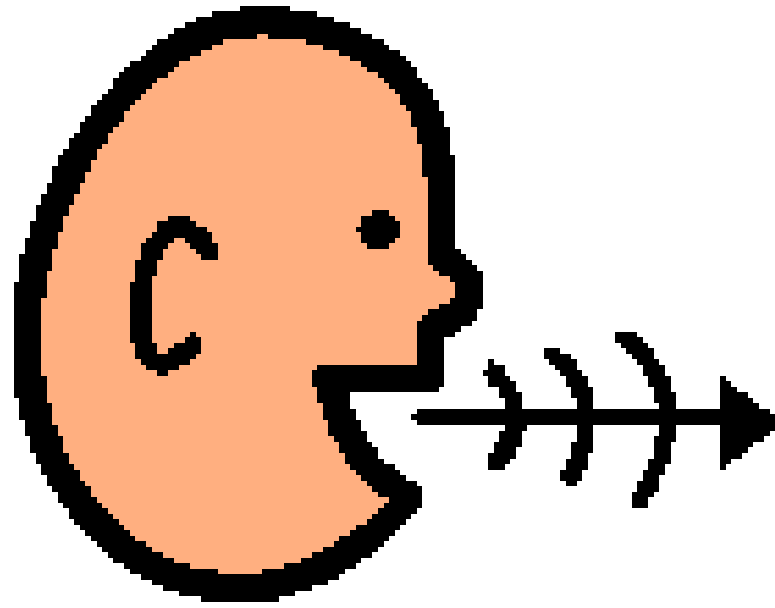
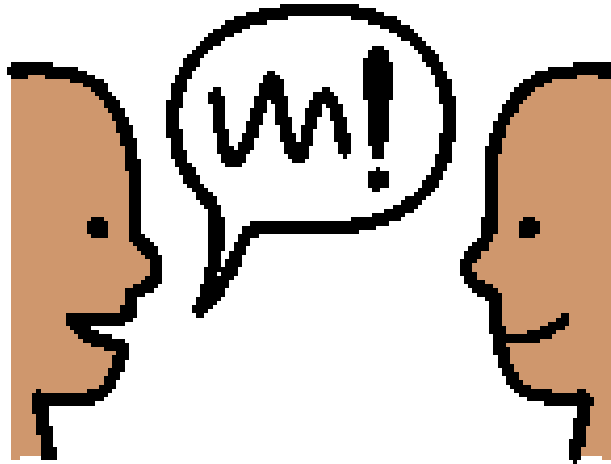


STONE OF VOICE

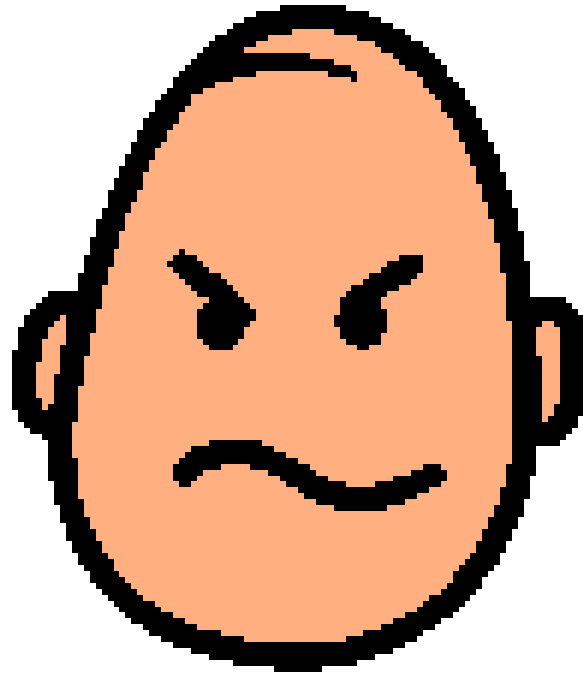

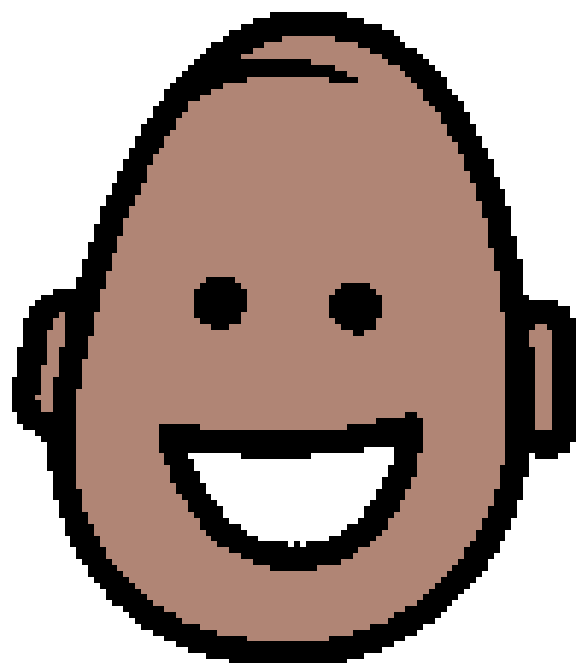


The way my voice sounds is called
the tone of my voice.

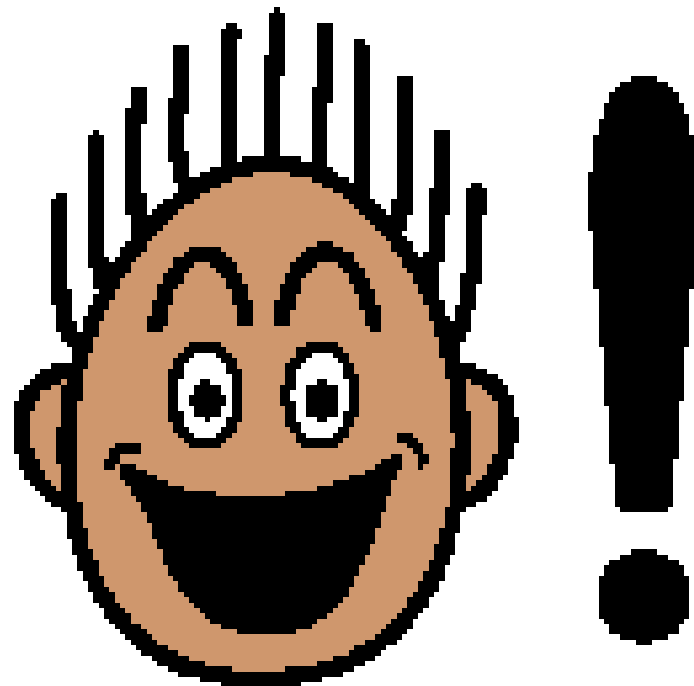
There are lots of different tones of voice I can use.



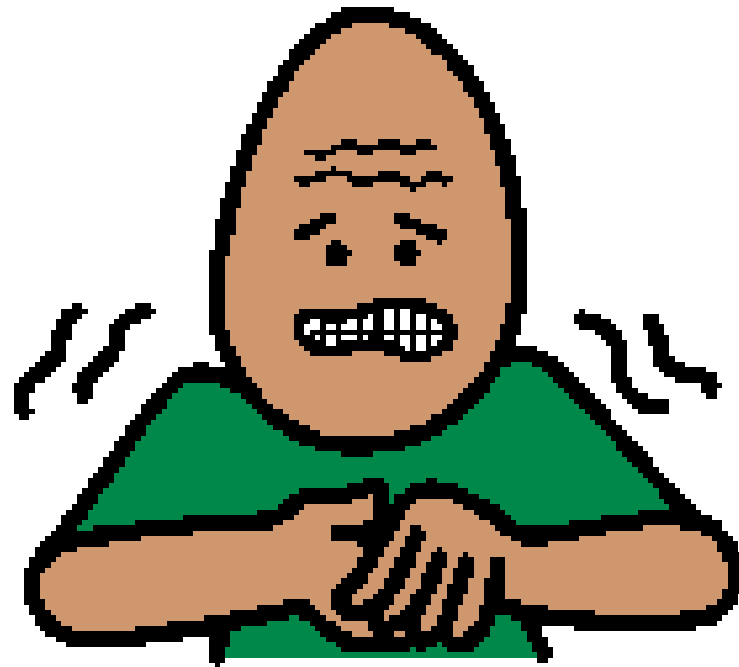
My voice can sound mad.



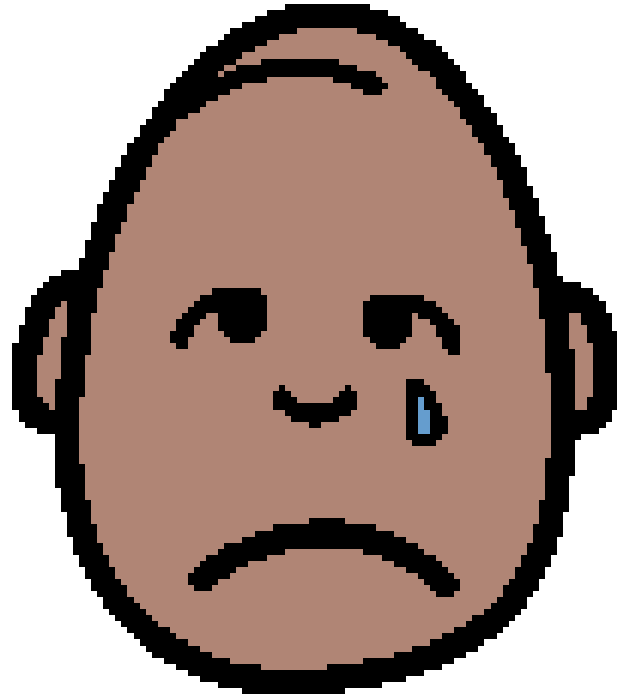
My voice can sound happy.



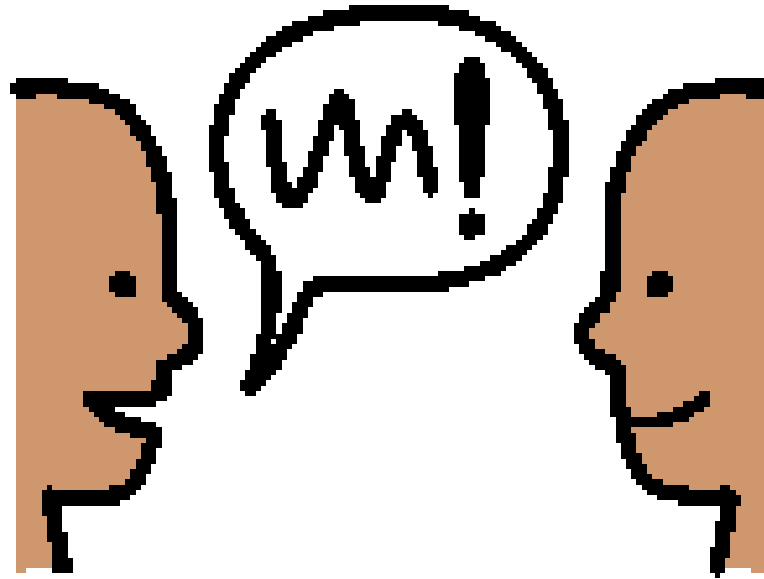
My voice can sound excited.



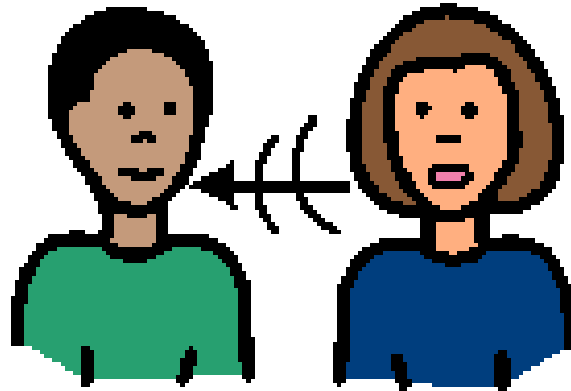
My voice can sound scared.



My voice can sound sad.



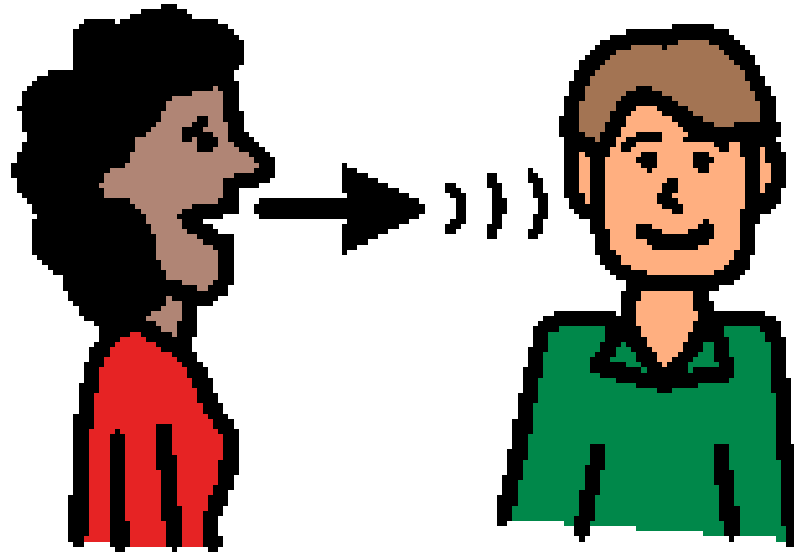
Sometimes my voice just sounds regular.
My regular voice is the voice I use most of the time.



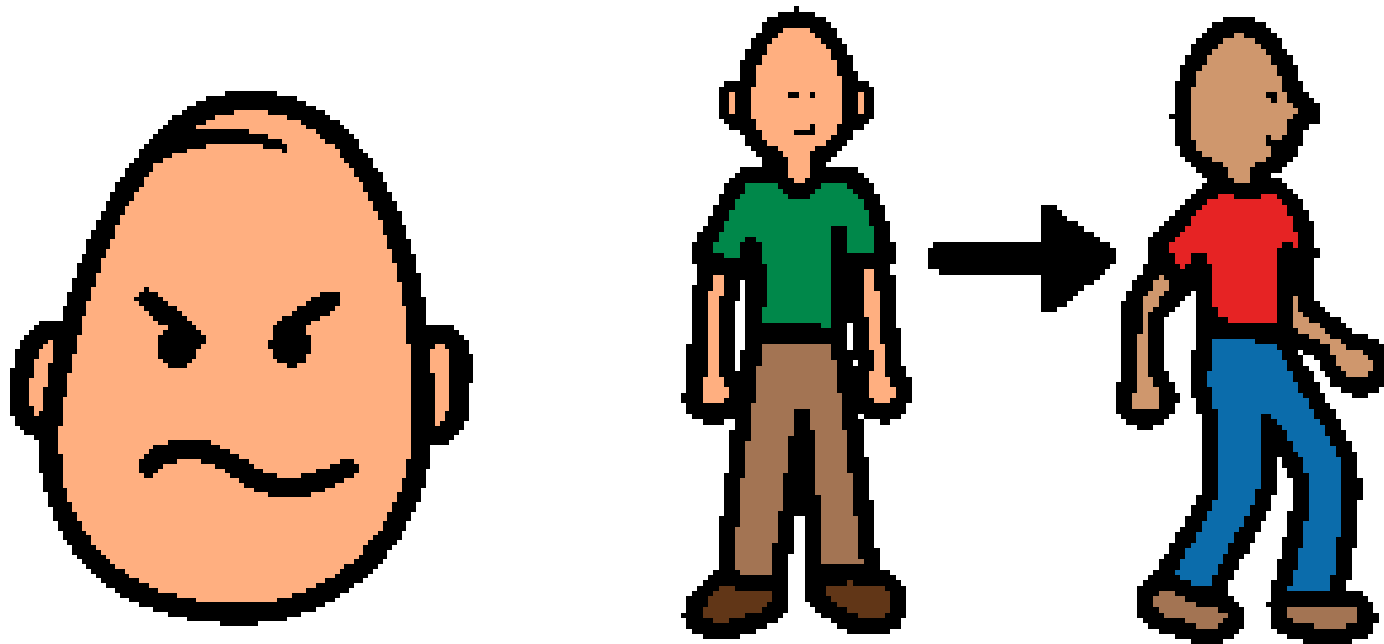
I use my voice to talk to other people.

Sometimes I ask people for things.

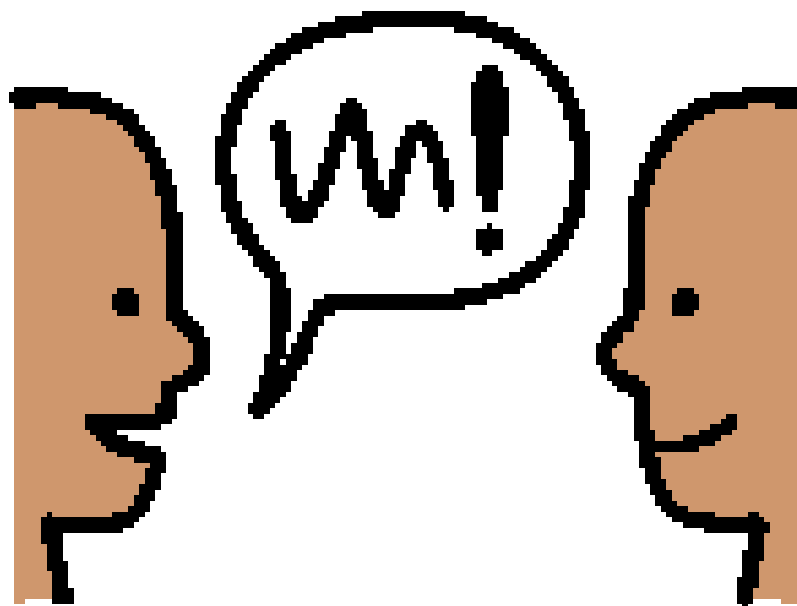
I should probably use my regular voice or my happy voice to ask people things.
